GENERAL INFORMATION

Skaters will not be permitted to register for the competition if they have not paid all outstanding registration fees in full. If outstanding fees are being paid at registration, only certified cheques or cash will be accepted.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES-LATE ENTRIES-INCOMPLETE FORMS ... All entries must be received no later than August 14, 2009.

An "entry" consists of the following:

- For Competitive Singles and Pairs (Entry Form, Entry Fee, and acceptable proof of age where relevant)
- For Competitive Dance (Entry Form, Entry Fee, acceptable Proof of Age where relevant and in the case of Junior and Senior Original Dance list the Dance Rhythm Title chosen)
- For STARSkate (Entry Form, Entry Fee, acceptable Proof of Age)
- Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the EOS Championship Chair and the Technical Representative.
- Sending the entry form by Fax will **not** be accepted.

If an entry form is incomplete Skaters will be notified via email by the Registrar; the skater will have 48 hrs to forward the missing material - in the event the said material is not forwarded in time the entry form will not be accepted.

CONFIRMATIONS AND SCHEDULE OF EVENTS ... This Season the Event Schedule, Skater Confirmations and Starting Order (*first event only*) will be posted on the Section Website www.skate-eos.on.ca - they will **not** be mailed out via Canada Post. Events may proceed up to one-half hour prior to the published schedule.

EVENT SCHEDULE ... STARSkate events will take place on Thursday, September 17, 2009 only. As space will be limited, entries for STARSkate will be accepted on a first come first serve basis. Therefore it is important to get your entry form in as quickly as possible. Competitive Events may commence on Thursday and run through to Sunday.
